## First International Politics Panel of the Semester with Molly Selvin and David Rubenson

On Tuesday May 14, 2019, REAF co-director Prof. Dr. Stephan Bierling hosted REAF's first international politics panel of the semester entitled "Did We Make a Difference? Citizen Volunteers and the 2018 US-Congressional Election Outcome", with his guests Molly Selvin and David Rubenson.
