At 97.10 in G (9 M-A, 3 M-R, 7 L-A).

M has a lacuna.

H has 3+3+4 R, the last an incipit for a commune R. H also has incipits for an A at each of the little hours. The Ac is for Calixtus.

R has an A for Calixtus after 2V-Am.

D has access to the same central tradition, but in a secular form (see last 2 M-A and M-R9-11). Similarly F (last 2 M-A, M-R), S (M-R). L has only 4+5 M-A, 10 M-R..

S has incipits for chants elsewhere at 1V, apart from 1V-Am as given. The series are disordered, when compared with other sources. There is a commune L-R, incipits for the little hours and 2V, apart from 2V-Am as given.

The nucleus would seem to be about 10 M-A, 4 L-A and 9 M-R:
