C has two offices, both composed entirely of incipits from the Commune, with the exception of M-I in both offices, and the first M-A of the second, *Te trina deitas unaque posci-*

The first 5 R in B are from elsewhere (not only from the Commune but also from the Sanctorale).

There are two offices in E. In the first R 2-8 are from elsewhere. The second office is given here a1, a2 etc.

V has mostly incipits for R from elsewhere. Only full R given here (no. 4 out of 4 in First Noct., 4-5 out of 5 in Second Noct., 1-3 out of 6 in Third Noct.). For L-A only inc. Then comes another proper Lauds and 2Vespers (a).

H originally had not a full set of M-R but only 1 inc. and 3 R at the end of M. Incipits for others added later (not given here) (now 4+5+5 R; 12-14 given here). There are 4 extra A after 2V, here reckoned with L-Ab.

R has 4 R inc. + 4 R inc. + 1 R inc. and 3 full R (rather like H). Only the latter given (10-12).

D actually gives many pieces from elsewhere in full (Dionysius!), including many appearing only as incipits in other sources here and therefore not marked. So All Saints is a tour through the Sanctorale. 4+4+5 R, the twelfth being an incipit.

F has 6+4+4 R.

S has 6+3 M-A followed by 3 commune incipits.

In L there are only incipits for R 2, 3, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12. Only the A at Prime is given in full.

CO has only incipits, some for saints, some for BVM (not entered here)

AR has only a few incipits, not entered here.
