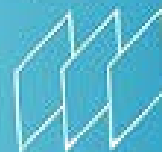

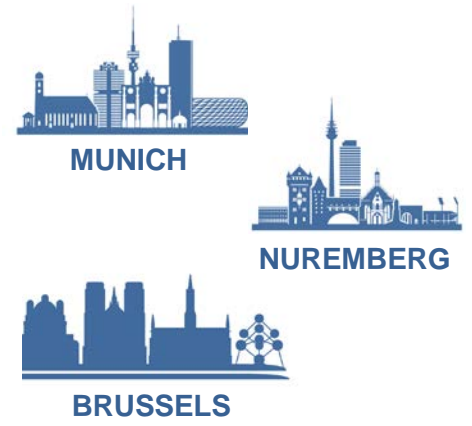

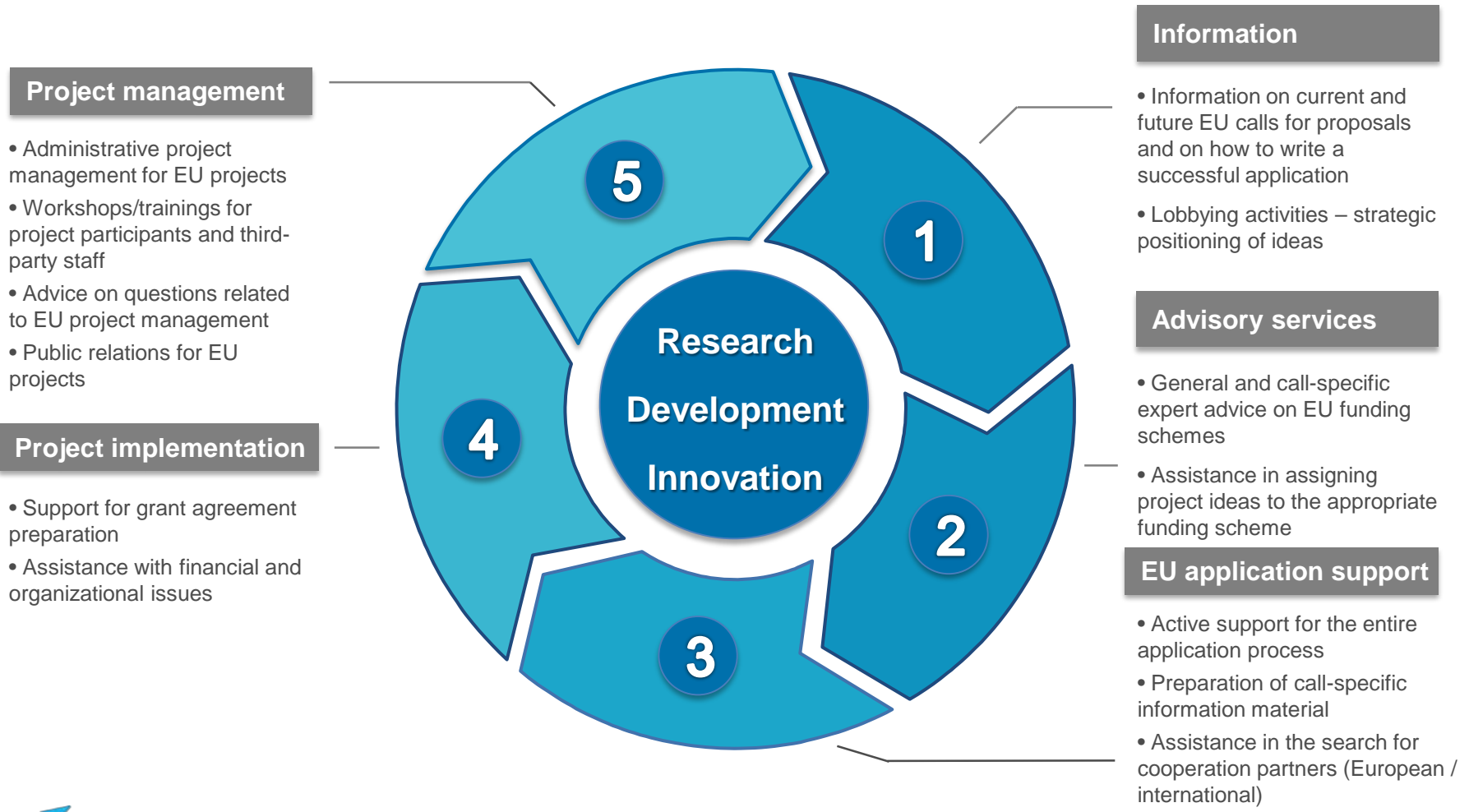

BayFOR as a partner institution in the Bavarian Research and Innovation Agency

Initiative of the Bavarian state government in order to improve:

European funding for research, development and innovation projects

We provide support for participation in European R&D funding programmes, esp. Horizon Europe, but also programmes such as Eurostars, Alpine Space, Danube Transnational Programme etc.

- Provide targeted information and consultancy services
- Initiate projects and match project outline with call requirements
- Set up contacts between academia, industry and politics
- Search for local and international project partners
- Support for proposal preparation and application process
- Support for grant agreement preparation
- Assistance in project management, dissemination and public relations activities

Bavarian University Funding Programme for the Initiation of International Projects (BayIntAn)

BayFOR is entrusted to run this funding programme

Goals:

- Establishing and strengthening scientific cooperation between scientists at Bavarian state and state supported non-state universities, universities of applied sciences and international research institutes
- Increasing international network and cooperation of Bavarian scientists
- Promoting Bavaria as a centre for science and innovation in the international research landscape to further strengthen Bavaria as an essential partner location
- Increasing the participation of Bavarian universities and universities of applied sciences in international funding projects, in particular in EU research & innovation projects
- Maximum grant per application: € 10,000
- Purpose for which the money is used: grants for travel and accommodation expenses and in exceptional cases material costs.

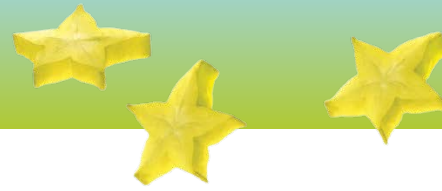

Since 2007 WKS has become a contact point for research cooperation with the Canadian Province of Alberta.

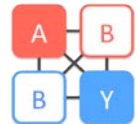
