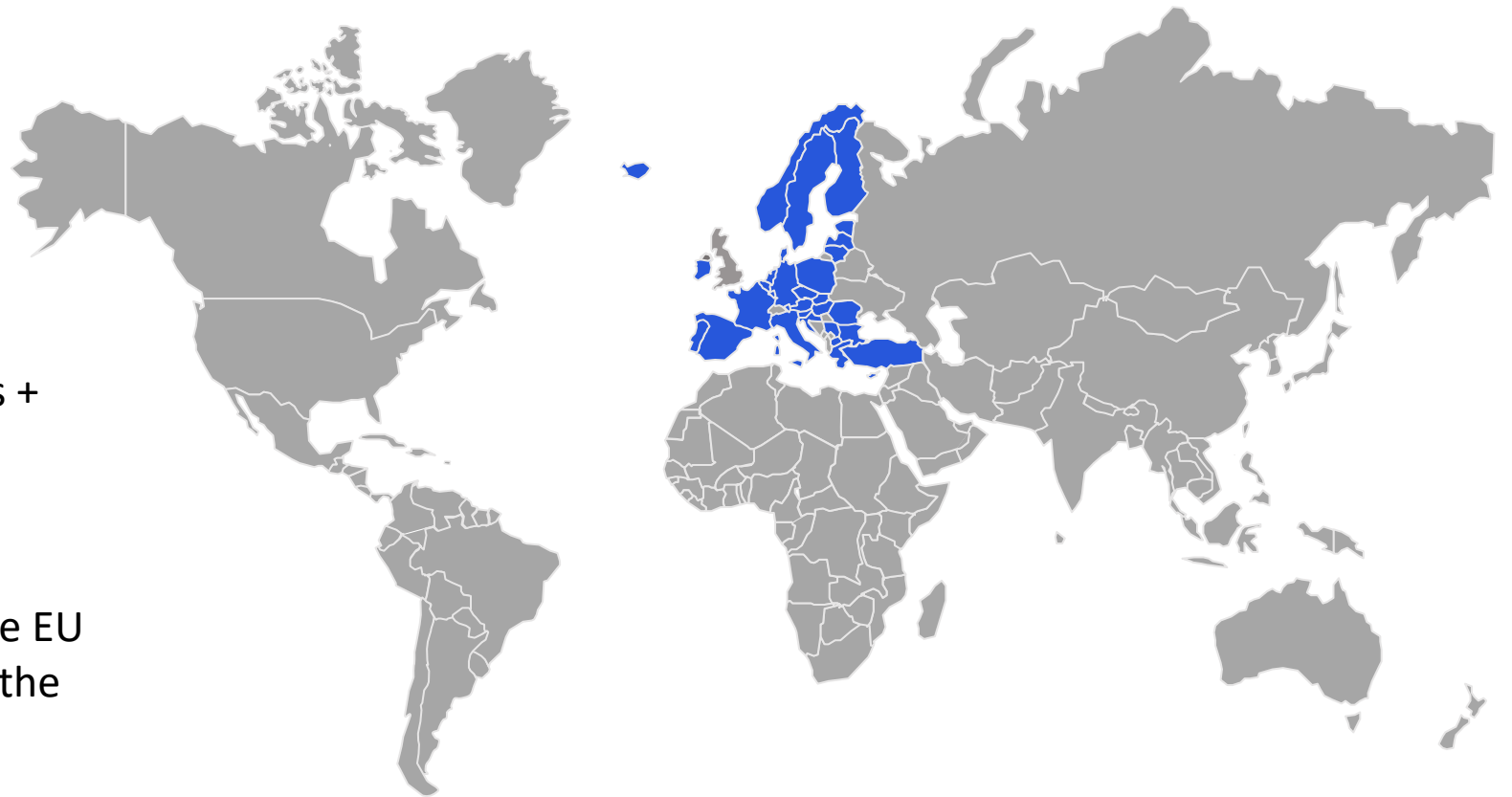

Staff mobility (for teaching and training)

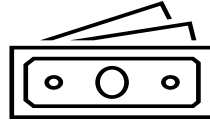
Who can participate?

- HEIs from programme countries, HEIs from a partner country recognised by competent authorities
- Any public or private organisation active in the labour market („non-academic partner")

Who can apply?

Only HEIs in programme countries

 - Students with a disability or chronic illness
 - Students with children

- Organisational support for sending and receiving institutions

Blended Mobility:

Every mobility can be undertaken as „Blended Mobility“. Blended Mobility is a combination of physical mobility combined with a virtual component that allows a collaborative online study experience, exchange and team work.
