

One-year scholarship program sponsored by the Free State of Bavaria for graduates of Central, Eastern and Southeastern European states Call for application for the funding year 2024/25

- advice for first time applications -

The Free State of Bavaria will sponsor scholarships for the academic year 2024/25. Graduates from Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia and Ukraine are eligible to apply. The scholarships are meant to finance postgraduate studies (i.e. master's programs), PhDs or one-year research sojourns at Bavarian higher education institutions.

A. <u>As an applicant for a one-year scholarship by the Free State of Bavaria you</u> need to:

- have the citizenship of one of the following countries: Bulgaria, Croatia, Poland, Romania, Russia, Slovakia, the Czech Republic, Hungary, Serbia, or Ukraine.
- be living full-time in your home country at the time of application.
- be no older than 30 (for master's degree students) or 35 (for doctoral candidates) in the first year of your scholarship (i.e. on October 1st, 2024). However, justified exceptions are possible, please see our FAQ / question 9.
- be needy, meaning that you are not able to finance your studies at a Bavarian higher education institution yourself, nor through the funds of a third party (for example through a scholarship from another institution).
- provide evidence of your German and / or English language skills according to your intended study program in Bavaria. Your language skills should be at a level that you can master seminars and academic papers in German or English without difficulty (generally C1 level of the CEFR).
- be able to give evidence at the time of application that you have achieved / or will achieve a distinctively above-average university degree in your home country.
- be matriculated in a master's or PhD program at a Bavarian University, University of Applied
 Sciences or Art Academy of your choice during the period of your granted scholarship. At the time
 of the scholarship application the enrolment is not yet required.

B. Criteria of selection:

- previous academic achievements (i.e. grades, scholarships or prizes, publications, talks at conferences etc.)
- letter of motivation: make it clear from your application that your postgraduate-studies are a continuation of your previous studies to a certain extent and will bring you closer to your professional goal
- description of your project (for PhD proposals only): convincing description of your research project and the academic relevance of your topic of research
- very good knowledge of the German and / or English language
- practical experience (e.g. internships, voluntary work, part-time jobs)
- international experience (e.g. studies or internships abroad)
- participation at conferences / non-curricular seminars / other advanced training etc.
- foreign languages
- voluntary work and commitments (e.g. student representation, theatre groups, sports associations, political clubs)
- letter of endorsement of a Bavarian higher education institution (recommended for master's degree applications; mandatory for PhD in Bavaria / one-year research sojourns in Bavaria as part of the PhD in the home country)
- letter of recommendation of the PhD supervisor from the home institution (only for PhDs conducted in the home country)
- online interview on the submitted application (if applicable)
- In addition, please indicate whether there is any kind of scientific cooperation in your field of studies between the university where you graduated and the Bavarian higher education institution of your choice. Please note that this is not mandatory for your application. Nevertheless, the annual scholarship program is supposed to enhance international scientific cooperation of Bavarian higher education institutions.

C. <u>Basic conditions for the awarding of the scholarship</u>

- The Sponsorship is generally granted for a maximum period of three years. The scholarship is given for one year (at most until the master or PhD graduation) and can be extended twice for each further year by application. In case of a PhD in Bavaria it's possible to obtain via a third extension further funding for one or two semesters in well justified and comprehensible documented exceptional cases.
- One-year research sojourns in Bavaria as part of a PhD in your home country can also be funded; however, the funding period is in this case restricted to one year. Student exchange years as part of a master's program in your home country <u>cannot</u> be supported.
- The scholarship holders are responsible themselves for their arrival at the respective place of study. Visa modalities must be arranged and clarified beforehand at the German embassy or consulate in the home country by the scholarship holder. Travel costs are not accorded.

- The scholarship is paid in twelve monthly instalments of 934,- €.
- Scholarship holders with at least one child can apply for family allowance (160,- € per month). Please inform BAYHOST / BTHA ASAP and note that the family allowance might be only granted for the subsequent financial year after application.
- The scholarship is usually paid out directly by BAYHOST / BTHA at the beginning of each month. For this purpose, we need the German bank account details or those of an EU account (possible banking charges must be covered by the recipient) and an address in Bavaria from every scholarship holder.
- Scholarship holders are obliged to attend the scholarship holders' meetings (i.e. the annual weekend seminar, reception for scholarship holders).
- Only necessary if no final university diploma was available by the time of application: Candidates
 selected for a scholarship are obliged to submit BAYHOST via email upon receipt of the scholarship
 ASAP the university diploma along with an authenticated German or English translation including a
 transcript of records. Applicants from the Czech Republic receiving a scholarship from the BTHA may
 submit copies of the university diploma including a transcript of records (in Czech, English or
 German without certified translation).
- Scholarship holders are obliged to provide BAYHOST / BTHA with evidence of their current matriculation (i.e. copy of enrolment certificate).
- The study program must take place primarily in Bavaria.
- Funding can only be given for study programs conducted at Bavarian state higher education institutions and at three church universities (Katholische Universität Eichstätt-Ingolstadt, Katholische Stiftungsfachhochschule München and Evangelische Fachhochschule Nürnberg).
- On approval of BAYHOST / BTHA, scholarship holders can receive up to 800€ gross per month (e.g. work, scholarship). A combination with another scholarship is possible if this is less than 450€ per month.
- In general, funding can only be given for study programs that do not charge any additional course fees (administration fees are exempted here).

D. <u>Time frame: selection of scholarships for the academic year 2024/2025</u>

E. <u>List of documents needed in the application (first time application)</u>

All documents must be submitted online using our StipSys form. It is not possible to submit your application by post or email.

- Please fill out our <u>online form via StipSys</u> and upload the following documents in PDF format (max.
 MB per file) at the end of the form:
- 2. a **letter of motivation** in German or English (1 2 DIN A4 pages)
- 3. proof of your German and / or English skills (please also see the FAQ)
- 4. your **university diploma including a transcript of records** along with an authenticated German or English translation (for Czech applicants in Czech, English or German without certified translation)

In case you will finish your studies until July 2024, please add confirmation from your university that you are expected to graduate successfully by 31st July 2024. Further, please include an overview of your previous grades (i.e. university transcript).

- 5. **proof of citizenship** (scan of your passport or identity card)
- 6. **letter of endorsement** ("Betreuungszusage") from a professor or alternatively from the course coordinator of a master's program **of a Bavarian higher education institution (recommended for master's degree applications; mandatory for PhDs in Bavaria / one-year research sojourns in Bavaria as part of the PhD in the home country, please see the FAQ):**

A letter of endorsement is an informal letter in which a Bavarian professor confirms that he or she will supervise you (i.e. your dissertation or academic work). The letter has to be signed and written on the official paper of the department. Sending the signed letter as a scanned attachment by email is possible. Should you encounter difficulties getting a letter of endorsement please contact us immediately via guttenberger@btha.de (for applicants with the citizenship of the Czech Republic) or doeppe@bayhost.de (for inquiries from other countries).

- 7. **a tabular CV** in German or English
- 8. optional: **additional documents** on volunteering, internships, further trainings, publications etc. (without translations, maximum of 5)
- 9. <u>additional documents for PhD:</u> a **two-page project description** and **time schedule** of your entire research project
- 10. <u>additional documents for one-year research sojourns</u> in Bavaria as part of a PhD in the home country: a **two-page project description** and **time schedule** of your entire research project; **letter of recommendation** of your supervisor in your home country explaining the importance of the aspired research sojourn.
- 11. in case you are applying for an **exception of the age limit**: informal letter explaining the specific reasons, please see our FaQ / question 9.
- 12. in case you are applying for a <u>family allowance</u>: Birth certificate of your child along with an authenticated German or English translation; for Czech applicants' copies without certified translations are sufficient.

First time applications must be submitted online via StipSys at BAYHOST / BTHA by 1st December 2023.

This date is a cut-off period! Late applications cannot be considered and will be excluded from the selection process. The same applies to applications that are incomplete or do not comply with the set formalities.

F. <u>Instructions for completing the online form</u>

First of all, you will be asked questions about your CV and certificates: Please note that a good application takes time, so please take the necessary time and peace that is required to complete your application. If you have the relevant documents at hand when filling in the form, it should take you about 30min (working steadily through it) to complete it. Important: If the form is inactive for too long, the session is automatically terminated. In addition, it is not possible to save the form temporarily. We therefore recommend preparing all documents BEFORE filling the form in and updating the form window in your browser (e.g. F5 key in Windows). Please process the form quickly afterwards and do not leave it open for a longer period.

All needed documents must be uploaded at the end of the form: Only files in PDF format with a maximum of 5 MB per file are permitted. Please note that in case of the defined upload-categories (e.g. letter of motivation, university diploma) only one file can be uploaded per category (this means e.g. that different university diplomas and grade overviews must be merged into one PDF-file). At the end, however, you can also upload additional documents as separate files under "further attachments".

Afterwards please click on "Continue to privacy" and accept it.

It is necessary to register at StipSys to finally submit your application: Please enter your name, your country of origin as well as your e-mail address and assign a password. If you have already previously applied via StipSys (also to other funding organizations), please make sure that you have your password ready. If you have forgotten your password, you can <u>reset it</u>.

After submitting your application, you will receive an e-mail confirming that your application has been received and an e-mail to activate your e-mail address. Please click on the activation link so that your application can be processed.

It's no longer possible to make any changes to the submitted application. However, you are welcome to contact the responsible contact persons at BAYHOST & BTHA if there are any additions to your application. You also have the option to delete your application completely. Please log in to StipSys with your access data and click on "Withdraw application". Your withdrawn application will then no longer be considered in the scholarship selection. If you have submitted more than one application, only the most recent application will be considered.

H. <u>Useful advice for the compilation of a good application</u>

DO's

The **letter of motivation** offers you the chance to give your application a personal touch and of convincing us of your study or research project. You have to assume that your fellow applicants have similarly good or even better academic results, language skills and international experiences than you. Through your letter of motivation you can persuade us that <u>you</u> deserve a scholarship.

- Explain why a study visit at the Bavarian higher education institution of your choice is important for your studies or the realization of your project.
- Place your study project within an **academic or professional context** by elaborating your future plans.
- Elucidate how your **qualifications and practical experience** suit your study project and convince us that you are well prepared to conduct your study or research project successfully.
- Illustrate an evident relation between your project and your motivation.
- Tell us what you expect from your participation in the scholarship program. What do you hope to gain from this international experience? How will you apply the knowledge that you gained and the experiences that you made in Bavaria after your study sojourn in Bavaria? And how could you later contribute furthermore to our alumni network?

Please use the **project description (for PhD proposals only)** to explain the most important aspects of your research project and try to have a logical and clear structure. Considering the multitude of applications sent in, the essential aspects of your research project should quickly become clear. A clearly worded question, precisely defined objectives as well as the illustration of your methodical approach to research make it apparent that you have been deeply involved with your object of investigation and hence can provide a concept that can be realistically realized in the time and scope proposed by you. Point out the significance of your project for research and your own professional development. Please use entire sentences and not only bullet points.

In case of a **one-year research sojourn as part of the PhD in your home country** please clearly point out how the research sojourn in Bavaria is in terms of content and time embedded in your <u>entire</u> PhD. Please also explain the positive impact of the research sojourn on your entire PhD and submit a time

schedule for your entire PhD including the stay in Bavaria. In addition, you should emphasize your specific reasons for your decision to conduct your research sojourn at the chosen higher education institution in Bavaria.

Basic Points:

- The separate parts of your application should form a whole. Hereby, a clear and logical structure of your application is crucial: your skills and knowledge will already be mentioned in the document of application, moreover documented in your Curriculum Vitae and confirmed through copies of diplomas etc. The letter of endorsement shows us that you are in contact with a Bavarian higher education institution and that the person responsible deems your project deserves to be supported.
- Remember to **take charge** of your search for a supervisor and with that the **letter of endorsement very early on**. The curricular rhythm of the Bavarian higher education institutions
 can vary from the academic curriculum in your home country, so that you have to anticipate delays,
 in case your contact is not there or does not have time for you immediately.

DON'Ts

- When describing your project try to use language that is understandable without unnecessary expert terminology. The members of the expert commission are from different fields; hence your project description needs to be understandable to all. Please note that a project description, which is not worded clearly, is hard to judge.
- Avoid vague and elusive phrasing. A frequent mistake is an unclear project description or a poorly conceived plan that lacks a clearly distinguishable concept.
- Remember that the letter of motivation ought to illustrate why you want to study or conduct your research at a Bavarian higher education institution. The fact that you like the country, and its people is not a convincing argument.
