The **Faculty of Medicine** invites applications for a

W 3 Professorship for Immunometabolism offered as a civil servant position

and commencing as soon as possible. The successful candidate is expected to represent his specialty in teaching and research. The professorship is intended to strengthen the faculty's focus in the field of immune medicine. The position is also expected to contribute to tumor research and transplantation medicine as other main research foci of the Faculty. In particular, the professorship should concentrate on the role of metabolic processes during the interaction of immune and tissue cells in autoimmunity, in transplantation immunology, in infectious diseases, in cardiovascular diseases, in the nervous system or in cancer.

The Faculty is looking for a scientifically excellent person in the field of immunometabolism with a strong willingness for interdisciplinary cooperation in regional, national as well as international networks. The professorship for immunometabolism is planned to be integrated into an innovative interdisciplinary Department for Immunomedical Research together with other professorships to be newly filled in the Faculty. Furthermore, the existing collaborative research programs in immune medicine at the Faculty of Medicine and the University of Regensburg as well as the Regensburg Center for Interventional Immunology (RCI) and a Fraunhofer Group for Personalized Tumor Therapy as non-university research institutions offer an attractive framework for the professorship. It is expected that the applicant teaches in the areas of medical, biomedical or natural sciences.

Required qualifications for applicants include a university doctoral degree, pedagogical aptitude and additional scientific merits (habilitation, junior professorship or equivalent scientific credentials, possibly from outside of academia).

As we are seeking to increase the number of female faculty members, women are strongly encouraged to apply. In addition, University of Regensburg supports work-family balance (for further information, visit <http://www.uni-regensburg.de/equal-opportunities/index.html>).
