This teaching associate program involves:

- teaching German on an elementary or intermediate level: oral practice sessions with students, tutoring and office hours, creation of syllabi for the 3 ½-week winter study period in January, organization of cultural events and day trips
- a salary of ca. \$400 every two weeks
- free tuition, housing, and meal plans
- collaboration with a TA from Austria

- a cover letter of approx. 2 pages that clearly states your motivation for applying and addresses the following questions:
  1. Which image of Germany would you want to present to students at Williams College?
  2. How would studying at Williams College and participating in student organizations on campus contribute to deepening your academic and personal interests?
  3. What kind of practical experience, e.g. as a teacher of young adults or secondary school students, do you have?
  4. Share some intercultural (professional) experiences that you have made, e.g. through stays abroad, travels, excursions, or practical experience! How has this contributed to broadening your horizon and your understanding of cultural diversity?
- your **CV** (including information on the exact degree you are enrolled in, stays abroad and excursions, practical experiences, voluntary commitments, extracurricular activities, interests, and hobbies)

- a FlexNow transcript of records
- a copy of your *Abiturzeugnis* (“unbeglaubigt”)
- a letter of recommendation by an academic instructor of your choice (2 copies)
