## Please send all application documents in <u>one PDF-file</u> and in the following order:

- 1) **CV** (including name, address and email address)
- 2) Cover letter
- 3) APS-Certificate (only for applicants from China, Vietnam and Mongolia)
- 4) Copy of passport (only for international applicants)
- 5) English-language certificate (level C1 or higher or equiv.)<sup>1</sup>
- 6) **B.A.-certificate**
- 7) Certified translation of B.A.-certificate (only if certificate is NOT in German or English)
- 8) **Transcript** of academic records including <u>average grade</u>
- 9) Certified translation of transcript (only if transcript is NOT in German or English)
- 10) Secondary school-leaving certificate (high-school or equiv.)
- 11) Certified translation of secondary school-leaving certificate (only if certificate is NOT in German or English)
- 12) Writing sample

## Please name your application file as follows:

- Application for M.A. English Linguistics: ELG\_FAMILY NAME\_given name\_2021
  e.g. If your name is Chen Qingqing and you want to apply for the M.A. English
  Linguistics, please name the application file ELG\_CHEN\_Qingqing\_2021.
- Application for **M.A. British Studies**: BLK\_FAMILY NAME\_given name\_2021 e.g. If your name is Peter Miller and you want to apply for the M.A. British Studies, please name the application file BLK\_MILLER\_Peter\_2021.
- If you wish to apply for **more than one programme**, please send <u>separate</u> <u>application files</u> for each subject and indicate your preference in your email. (i.e. What is your first / second choice?)
