Information on deregistering for a first attempt when terminating your enrollment, or changing program or university

Should you terminate your enrollment, or change programs or university, this has no effect on the examination rules for a course or examination you are registered for.

- If you do not cancel your registration in good time, the examination or course will be counted as missed.
- This leads, when all the attempts have passed, to the loss of the right to take examinations in the relevant program.
- We therefore recommend that **before you terminate your enrollment**, you check the courses you are registered for, and cancel the registration for any that you no longer wish to complete.
- Courses and examinations that have already been started may still be completed if the pass date is in the same semester as the termination of enrollment.
