

Module group balancing for the business modules in Business Chemistry

Bachelor's degree

(Examination regulations for the B.Sc. in Business Chemistry § 8 Para. 5 from August 1, 2017, amended May 26, 2021):

A module group is successfully completed when at least **two** of the module examinations are passed and the average grade determined according to clause 2 is 4.0 or better.

A module group can no longer be successfully completed when, after using up the possibilities for retakes, it is no longer possible to complete **more than the half of the modules** with an average grade of 4.0 or better, or the average grade given in clause 3 as necessary for successful completion can no longer be achieved.

Master's degree

(Examination regulations for the M.Sc. in Business Chemistry § 8 Para. 5 from August 3, 2020, amended December 20, 2021):

A module group is successfully completed when at most **one** of the module examinations in the module group is failed and the average grade determined according to clause 5 is 4.0 or better.

A module group can no longer be successfully completed when, after using up the possibilities for retakes, **more than one module** has not been graded 4.0 or better or the average grade given in clause 5 as necessary for successful completion has not been achieved.

Old regulation on module group balancing:

In order for module group balancing to take place, all the examination components must have been taken, and any retakes for **those components which were not passed** must also have been taken (passed, not passed, missed).

New regulation on module group balancing (due to a resolution from the examination board on July 21, 2022): The option to retake an examination component can, from now on be waived, and module group balancing subsequently calculated. To do this, it is necessary to submit a written waiver.

Retaking an examination:

The retake is to be taken in the subsequent semester at the latest.

Note:

- If you register for a retake and take part: Your grade may be better or worse.
- > You register for the retake but do not take part. You will be awarded the grade "defaulted", 5.0. You should avoid this possibility.
- If you do not register for the retake and do not submit the retake waiver: After the deadline for the retake of the relevant examination component has passed, the module group balancing will take place at the start of the following semester. The grade of the first attempt is booked.
