The technician will be involved in the development of a novel clinical-grade manufacturing platform for the generation of bispecific CAR T memory stem cells. The contract is for a limited period of up to two years but could be extended further depending on the availability of third-party funds.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Perform all tasks associated with the manufacturing of clinical-grade cell products including the development of standard operating procedures (SOPs), batch records and other GMP documentation.
- Conduct clinical assays required to support assessment of T cell therapies.
- Successfully troubleshoot processing and equipment issues.

- Strong analytical, organizational and time management skills.
