- You may only register for courses at the level which you achieved on your placement test or proven by a different certificate (see Prerequisites and Placement). If you register for classes at a different level, you will not receive a certificate nor ECTS credit points at the end of the semester.
- Be sure to register online before attending a class. If the online registration is not working, please contact the course assistant for the Complementary German Course Program.
- At your first class, please show the instructor confirmation of your current language level ("Zulassungsnachweis") so that the instructor can verify that you are attending the correct course level. You must have the confirmation of your current language level in order to receive a seat in the class and receive a course certificate and ECTS credit. If you do not have documentation confirming your language level, please contact the course assistant for the Complementary German Course Program.
- Recognition of accepted language proficiency certificates (see Prerequisites and Placement) can be obtained from the course assistant for the Complementary German Course Program.
