

Statutes of the GAMM-Activity Group “Analysis of Partial Differential Equations and Calculus of Variations”

1. Aims of the Activity Group

The activity group supports the communication and collaboration of all persons or groups interested in the mathematical analysis of partial differential equations and calculus of variations and their applications. It exclusively and directly pursues scientific objectives which contribute to the promotion, spreading and application of this research field. The activity group represents this research field within the GAMM and collaborates with similarly oriented organizations in Germany and abroad. More detailed information is provided on the websites.

2. Membership

Any person interested in the mathematical analysis of partial differential equations and calculus of variations can become a member of the activity group by applying to the executive board. Applications for admission shall be sent to the executive board which will make a decision on acceptance. The membership terminates either by resignation of the member or by exclusion. A member who has offended the aims of the Activity Group or damaged its reputation can be excluded by the executive board.

3. Organizational structure of the activity group

The general meeting and the executive board are the organizational instruments of the activity group. A general meeting shall be held at least once every two years. Each member present is entitled to vote. The general meeting reaches a quorum independently of the number of members present. The executive board is elected by the general meeting and consists of one spokesperson and at least two further members. The members serve for a two-year term. Candidates receiving the most votes will be elected. The executive board will determine one or two deputy spokespersons. The members of the executive board can resign at any time. If the spokesperson resigns, the executive board will determine a new spokesperson. In this case a new spokesperson has to be elected on the next general meeting.

4. Modification of the statutes

The statutes can be modified by simple majority of votes of the meeting of all members.

5. Termination of the activity group

The termination of the activity group can be decided by the executive board and the present members at a general meeting by a $2/3$ majority.
