Central teaching content:

The objective of this course is to explain, characterize and analyze the concepts of Corporate Social Responsibility Reporting and of Integrated Reporting (IR). The course will cover the existing international norms on CSR and IR reporting and the recent development in the European regulation. At the end of the course, students are able to analyze and critically assess CSR and integrated reports. Finally, they can depict and interpret the major research findings concerning the reasons for, implications of, and future challenges of integrating sustainability in business management and reporting.
