About the Fund

The MIT-Germany + University of Regensburg Seed Fund supports new research collaborations between faculty and research scientists at both institutions. Launched in 2019 as part of the long standing MIT-UR partnership, the fund provides joint seed grants of up to \$27,500. The program is open to all research disciplines.



Priority will be given to projects that:

- Propose a balanced exchange between MIT and University of Regensburg participants
- Demonstrate complementarity between the teams
- Involve undergraduate and/or graduate students

This fund is part of the **MIT Global Seed Funds** program. All general GSF eligibility, application, and evaluation criteria apply.
