

Code of Conduct – enjoy the celebration with respect and care

This code of conduct serves as a guideline for participant behaviour to ensure that everyone can feel comfortable at the event.

Core values of the University of Regensburg

We take a clear stand against all forms of discrimination and group-based hatred. The dignity of every person must be respected regardless of age, gender, sexual orientation, disability or chronic illness, social, ethnic and cultural background, parenthood, beliefs or religion.

Behaviour during celebrations

- Treat everyone fairly and with respect. Discrimination, (sexualized) violence and abusive actions, gestures or words will not be tolerated.
- Respect personal boundaries. Only YES means YES! Situations can change. If you are unsure whether consent still applies, it is better to ask.
- Boundary violations are taken seriously. As the person affected, you decide what constitutes a violation of your boundary.
- No one shall be pressured into consuming alcohol or drugs.
- Respect other people's pronouns and names.
- Mistakes are okay. Handle criticism respectfully.

Consequences for violations

In case of violations, warnings may be issued, individuals may be expelled from the event or excluded from future events and further measures may be taken. When boundaries are crossed, reflection and genuine remorse are prerequisites for continuing the conversation.

Awareness Team

The Awareness Team is committed to creating a safe space and is available if someone experiences or witnesses violence, discrimination or inappropriate behaviour or feels uncomfortable.
