Stand der Statistik: Januar 2019

Universität Regensburg (UREG), founded in 1962 as a regional university, has developed into a renowned centre of teaching and research with a strong tradition in international cooperation. The university provides a broad variety of disciplines, a favourable student-teacher ratio and excellent facilities. There are currently more than 21.000 students enrolled at UREG, including 1.800 international students.

In 2018, the university received 47,8 Mio. € external funding from competitive research grants and industry cooperation. The university hosts several large and distinguished research projects, including 8 ERC Grants and 9 Collaborative Research Centers funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG).

Modul Administrative Unterstützung

The central administration of Universität Regensburg (UREG) offers support to scientists working on third party funded research projects. Specialized support units address, amongst others, knowledge and technology transfer, equal opportunities, recruitment of scientific staff, procurement of technical equipment, support to incoming international researchers as well as professional development and career perspectives of Early Stage Researchers.
