### Program in Yiddish Language and Literature:

Hanan Bordin was born in Riga, Latvia, in 1958.

In 1978 he repatriated to Israel where he studied at the Hebrew and Yiddish Departments of The Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

Hanan teaches full time at the Yiddish Department of the Hebrew University, where he has several Yiddish classes at different levels, as well as a Yiddish linguistics class, taught entirely in Yiddish.

He has also taught the Yiddish language at Oxford University, Columbia University, NYU, Harvard University, Moscow State University, Maimonides Academy (Moscow) and Birobidzhan Sholem-Aleykhem University in Jewish Autonomous Region of Russia, in Lithuanian State University in Vilnius and at the National Yiddish Book Center in Amherst, Massachusetts.

Among his publications are Hebrew-Yiddish Conversational Book, Russian-Yiddish Conversational Guide, Vort ba vort (textbook for beginners), Mit vort un maysim (textbook for advanced students of Yiddish), English-Yiddish Dictionary of Place-Names.

At the University of Regensburg he teaches during the academic years 2015/2016 and 2016/2017 following courses in Yiddish:

- Yiddish for Beginners/Reading and Writing
- Yiddish for Intermediates/ Reading and Writing
- Yiddish for Advanced
- Reading for Advanced
