Tutorial on public law for beginners

The lecture trains the work on constitutional law cases with case discussions, class exercises and term papers. Previous knowledge of constitutional rights as well as at least contemporaneous attendance of the lecture law of public organization. The achievement of the course certificate assumes a term paper and a class exercises with at least 4 points (sufficient).

Administrative law I: General administrative law and law on administrative procedurel

Administrative law II including police and security law

ECTS credits: 8 Type: lecture

Level: 2nd year course 4 hpw, summer Language: German From the field of general administrative law, this course aims to further understanding of the doctrine of the administrative act, law of administrative service of notes and administrative enforcement, law of public compensation performance. From the law on administrative procedure: Protest procedure, temporary legal protection and exploring further the subjects covered during the winter semester.

In addition it deals with the compulsory fields of the first juridical state exam according to § 5 Abs. 2 Nr. 5c JAPO, literally the general security (Landesstrafpolice law Verordnungsgesetz, Polizeiaufgabengesetz und Polizeiorganisationsgesetz). Students introduced to the solution of facts in the police and security law. It is possible to sit a written exam at the end of the semester. Knowledge of general administrative law and the law on the administrative procedure will be necessary to pass the exam. It is strongly recommended that participants of this lecture also attend the lecture on General administrative law.

Administrative law III (building law and municipal law)

21 257 - Verwaltungsrecht III (Baurecht und Kommunalrecht)

ECTS credits: 8 Type: lecture

Level: 3rd year course

4 hpw, winter Language: German The main features of the law on building regulations and the law on planning for building projects are part of the compulsory subjects for the 1st Juridical state exam (Staatsexamen). Municipal law is a compulsory subject of special administrative law. In the first instance, the lectures expand constitutionally guaranteed rights of the municipal self-government, especially the tasks of the own and delegated sphere of functions as well as the instruments of public control. Particular attention is paid to the municipal right to issue charters and ordinances. A further main focus is the subject of public establishments of the municipalities and communal organization. In exploring these issues, the structure and function of the single organs, municipal election law and litigations about the constitution of the local authorities are also covered. To conclude, the law on economic activities and the fiscal charge law, as well as the different forms of municipal collaboration, are presented. The numerous influences of EU-law, especially on the subject of provision for elementary requirements, are dealt with in detail.

European law

This lecture features the complete mandatory range of this fascinating, dynamic, and important legal area. Starting point will be the inner constitution of the European Union, which will lead to an understanding of the most basic provisions, rules and mechanisms of the European contracts and the different areas of politics within the EU. To ensure the best possible preparation for succeeding in written examinations, the law of the European Union will be presented embedded in actual, recent cases that might be subject to assessment during the exams in this very form. This approach also trains to cope with problems that may arise at the boundary point of EU law and national law.
