- collaboration with a TA from Austria

- your CV (including information on the exact degree you are enrolled in, stays abroad and excursions, practical experiences, voluntary commitments, extracurricular activities, interests, and hobbies)

- a letter of recommendation by an academic instructor of your choice (2 copies)
