Your task will be teaching German in nursing secondary schools and schools of higher education in the Czech Republic. ### **NEED OF KNOWLEDGE OF CZECH LANGUAGE?**

### NUMBER OF TEACHING HOURS PER WEEK

Both of them are not situated in Prague, but to the east of Prague in two cities which lie close to each other. We will take care of the transportation between the cities and all the costs. The two cities are Havlickuv Brod and Zdar nad Sazavou.

Applicants will have to fill out an application form and a questionnaire (available via BAYHOST or directly from Ms Vegsoova) so that we know their requirements or ideas. The final number of hours depends on our mutual agreement.

## **CERTIFICATE**

The students will get a certificate that they have participated in our program that might serve as a confirmation of the practice.

## **LEARN CZECH LANGUAGE**

We will try to find some Czech courses for foreigners in one of the cities and if we are not successful in finding, we will try to arrange a deal with language teachers from the schools. So we will do our best in trying to find a way how the students can improve their Czech language skills.
