### I. Winter Semester 2018/19

**a) Preparatory intensive language course**  
for exchange students with German language skills including orientation

**Arrival Dates:** September 4 and 5, 2018  
(9.30 to 17.30)  
**Orientation Days:** September 6-09, 2018  
**Course Dates:** September 10 – October 05, 2018

**b) Orientation Course**  
for exchange students with intermediate German language skills

**Arrival Dates:** October 2 + 4, 2018  
(9.30 to 17.30)  
**Course Dates:** October 5 – October 11, 2018

**Start of lectures:** October 15, 2018  
**End of lectures:** February 09, 2019  
**Lecture-free days:** November 1, 2018 and December 24, 2018 until January 6, 2019

### II. Summer Semester 2019

**a) Preparatory intensive language course**  
for exchange students with German language skills below B2 including orientation

(9:30 to 17:30)  
**Orientation Days:** March 7 – 10, 2019  
**Course Dates:** March 11 – April 5, 2019

**b) Orientation Course**  
for exchange students with intermediate German language skills

**Arrival Dates:** April 8 + 9, 2019  
**Course Dates:** April 10 – April 16, 2019

**Start of lectures:** April 24, 2019  
**End of lectures:** July 27, 2019  
**Lecture-free days:** May 1, 10, 22 and 31, 2019

### **III. Examinations**

**Please note:** Examinations in the Faculty of Business, Economics and Management Information Systems take place in a period between the last week of the lectures

- and mid-March (for the winter semester)
- and mid-August (for the summer semester)

In all other faculties, exams usually take place during the last week of classes.

### **IV. Intensive Language Course and Orientation Course:**

Students with German language skills below level B2 should participate in the preparatory intensive language course (including orientation). All others are welcome to participate in the course. We offer all levels from A1 to C1. The language of instruction is German. However, all extra-curricular activities and explanation surrounding the course will be in English.

Exchange students who sign up for the Intensive Language Course are expected to arrive on the designated arrival dates and participate in the orientation program, as all questions referring to administrative formalities, choice of courses, study plans, finding their way in Regensburg and on campus are all dealt with during that time.
